WEATHERIZATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM PARTICIPANT

Working in partnership with Nevada Housing Division, Nevada Rural Housing Authority’s Weatherization Assistance Program helps reduce the cost of utilities and improve energy conservation for low-income Nevadans. Assistance is provided free of charge for those living in single-family homes, multi-family units and mobile homes. Owners of rental properties that qualify for weatherization service are required to pay 50% of capital improvement costs. Additional grant funding may be available to cover all or a portion of these costs and will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

The Weatherization Program is funded by the US Department of Energy and the Fund for Energy Assistance & Conservation.

SERVICES

Following is a list of typical services provided through Nevada Rural Housing Authority Weatherization Assistance:

- Attic, floor and duct insulation
- Duct leakage sealing
- Window replacement
- Water heater and water pipe insulation
- Furnace replacement
- Refrigerator replacement
- Installation of low flow shower head
- Carbon monoxide alarm installation

INCOME LIMITS

To qualify for Weatherization Assistance, your family must meet the certain household income limits. Please contact our office at (775) 887-1795, ext 124, or visit our website at www.nvrural.org for details.
